



**Golubev Leonid Pavlovich (1922-1977)**

My great-grandfather, Golubev Leonid Pavlovich, was called up for military service on August 2, 1941. From June 13, 1942 to May 9, 1945 he participated in the Great Patriotic War. He served as a scout, topographer. He was wounded in his right forearm, left leg and left arm.



Great-grandfather's feat, for which he received the Order of Glory II Degree.

On 8.04.1945 in the battle for Königsberg my great-grandfather with a group of scouts (3 people) challenged to go to station G. Pregel Königsberg for the purpose of exploration of the defensive line of the Nazi, and were machine-gun fired from the basement of the house. Great-grandfather secretly crawled to the house, threw grenades into the basement. Two hand-held machine guns were destroyed, seven Nazi people were taken prisoners, eleven enemies were killed. It was a great contribution to the

advance of the advancing infantry.



Great-grandfather's feat, for which he received the Order of the Red Star.

On 5.02.1945 in the battle near the town of Kragau, in East Prussia, comrade Golubev and 3 scouts crept up to the house with machine guns. Throwing grenades, our soldiers captured 3 Nazi soldiers and helped our troops advance further.

My great-grandfather could have participated in the Victory Parade and received the Order of Glory I Degree, but he chose to go home to his sick father. After the war he got married and worked as the chairman of a collective farm.
